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This course is only available to those who are currently undertaking an educational leadership role. It is designed for Directors of Medical, Nursing and Multiprofessional Education, AHP Leads, CPD and Workforce Planning Leads

Course dates three day course:

- Day 1: Thursday 29 June 2017
- Day 2: Wednesday 12 July 2017
- Day 3: Thursday 20 July 2017

Delivered by a multiprofessional team, this 3 day course will provide a range of interactive activities to stimulate reflection on individual perspectives and contemporary practice. Its key focus is educational policy and pedagogy in the healthcare practice workplace.

Aspects of educational leadership which will be addressed include:

- Practical – success and challenges of educational leadership, organising educational teams, implementing policy, negotiating and dealing with difficult learners and trainers
- Experiential – reflection on policy and practice; planning for change; self appraisal; problem solving
- Organisational – policy; culture; generational differences; procedure and protocol; motivating colleagues
- Psychological – behaviour, attitudes, values, beliefs; dealing with the reasons for difficult behaviour
- Pedagogical – educational methodologies and their impact on learning and patient care

Aspects of educational leadership which will be addressed include:

- Small group activities
- Short interactive lectures
- Discussions
- Paired work
- Problem solving
- Individual reflection
- Planning for practice

The sessions will include outside speakers from health care practice, research and industry. Opportunities to reflect on contemporary literature and policy in practical work will be provided for participants.

Solutions to challenges identified by the group will be presented at the end of the programme.
